Thanks for your cooperation.





In newspaper parlance, the most important articles are published "above the fold" because that is what the readers see first. The CCC newsletter will have a page titled "Above the T" (because honestly, playing behind the T is for the birds!) Think: "What's News" in the WSJ.

**If you read nothing else in the newsletter, read this page!** It will give you the highlights and most important pieces of information you need. But seriously.... read the whole newsletter anyway.

#### WINTER REGISTRATION

Registration for the Winter Leagues will open on December 12th and continue to December 16th. The registration process will be the same as it was for the fall session. <u>See page 4</u> for league information. Remember: You will not be permitted to register for winter events unless you are current on CCC bill payments through the end of October.

#### **KEEP IT CLEAN, FOLKS**

While we do have a club manager now, please remember that the CCC is still a volunteer club. This means that we do not have a cleaning crew everyday to come and clean up after each of us. Please do your part to keep the club tidy and pick up after yourselves (and others). Especially, please be sure to leave the kitchen in the same or better shape as when you found it if you will be using it.

#### **PROTECT THE ICE**

- Please do not let rocks hit the hacks. And please keep your hands and knees off the ice.
- Please <u>do not practice</u> on the ice if the "No Practice Ice" sign is posted.

#### **KNOW THE RULES**

Each league has its own scoring rules and substitution guidelines. Everyone should know what the substitution parameters are for each league. The <u>SKIPS</u> in particular need to know what the scoring and playing rules are so as to avoid a potential forfeiture.

- How many subs can you have in a game?
- How many minimum players do you have to have to start a game?
- What are the short handed playing rules for scoring?

#### **FINDING SUBS**

It is your responsibility to find a sub for yourself. Here are the steps/guidelines on how to do that:

- 1. Ask your skip if he/she has a preference for who you ask to sub
- 2. Check and contact the sublist in the comparable player category
- 3. Check and contact any players that may have the bye that week
- Contact the event chair letting them know that you have been unsuccessful in the above steps (they may have an idea of someone who is looking to play).
- 5. Post on the Virtual Warm Room (which is NOT a CCC sanctioned social media outlet, so NOT an official means of finding a sub, but it is a LAST RESORT OPTION.
- 6. If you are still unsuccessful, be sure to let your skip know. No one likes to play 3 handed, but it is better to be prepared for it than not.


